Continuous

Behavioral Indicators:

Non-verbal vocal complaints: Moan, groans, grunts, cries, gasps, sighs

Verbal vocal complaints: Trying to get attention (beckoning someone), exclamation of protest, repetitive vocalizations

Facial expressions: Grimace, clenched teeth, distorted expression

Restlessness: Shifting, rocking, inability to sit still

Movement: Rubbing, bracing, guarding, absence of movement, rigidity

Other: Withdrawal, outbursts, change in normal behavior patterns, change in cooperation with personal care
