

# How do I remove my payment card from Avast?– 2026

### Introduction

You want to remove your payment card from Avast so that they cannot charge you again. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 Maybe you are tired of worrying about automatic renewal. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 Maybe you switched to a different antivirus and do not want Avast to have your card on file. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 Or maybe you just want to clean up your account settings. ### Important: Know the Difference Between Removing a Card and Canceling a Subscription

Before you remove your payment card, you need to understand what this action actually does and what it does not do. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 Removing your payment card from Avast deletes the card information from your account so that Avast cannot use that card for future charges. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 However, removing your card does not cancel your subscription. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 If you have an active subscription and you remove your card, Avast may still try to charge you and then suspend your account when the payment fails, which could affect your credit score if you have a payment agreement. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 The correct order is to first cancel your subscription or turn off auto renewal, then remove your payment card. (+1)➤877➤419➤8702 If you remove your card while auto renewal is still on, Avast may send you emails asking for a new payment method, and they

could even send your account to collections in extreme cases.

(+1) 877 419 8702 If you bought Avast through Apple or Google, your payment card is stored with Apple or Google, not with Avast, so you must remove it from those platforms instead. (+1) 877 419 8702

## How to Remove Your Payment Card from Avast When You Bought Directly

If you purchased your Avast subscription directly from the Avast website, your payment card is stored in your Avast account. (+1) 877 419 8702 To remove it, first open your web browser and go to [account.avast.com](https://account.avast.com). (+1) 877 419 8702 Sign in with your email address and password; if you forgot your password, click the "Forgot password" link to reset it. (+1) 877 419 8702 Once you are signed in, look for "Payment Methods," "Billing Information," or "Payment Settings" in the menu. (+1) 877 419 8702 The exact wording may change over time, but the location is usually under the Subscriptions or Account Settings section. (+1) 877 419 8702 Click on Payment Methods, and you will see the credit card or debit card currently on file, often showing only the last four digits. (+1) 877 419 8702 Next to the card, look for an option that says "Remove," "Delete," or "Edit." (+1) 877 419 8702 Click "Remove" and confirm your choice when Avast asks you to verify. ## How to Remove Your Payment Card If You Bought Through Apple

If you purchased your Avast subscription through the Apple App Store, your payment card is stored with Apple, not with Avast. (+1) 877 419 8702 This means you cannot remove your card from within your Avast account because Avast never had your card information in the first place. (+1) 877 419 8702 Instead, you need to remove your payment card from your Apple ID. (+1) 877 419 8702 Be careful: removing your card from Apple will affect all your Apple subscriptions, including iCloud, Apple Music, and any other apps you pay for through Apple.

(+1) 877 419 8702 To remove your card from Apple on an iPhone or iPad, open the Settings app, tap your name at the top, then tap "Payment & Shipping."

(+1) 877 419 8702 You will see a list of your payment methods; tap on the card you want to remove, then tap "Remove Payment Method." (+1) 877 419 8702 If you have an active subscription (including Avast), Apple may not let you remove your card until you cancel that subscription. (+1) 877 419 8702 In that case, first cancel your Avast subscription through Apple (Settings → your name →

Subscriptions → Avast → Cancel Subscription), then go back to Payment & Shipping and remove your card. (+1) 877 419 8702 On a Mac, open the App Store, click your name in the bottom left corner, click "View Information," then scroll to Payment Information and click "Edit" or "Remove." (+1) 877 419 8702 If you still have trouble, call Apple Support because Avast cannot help you with Apple payments.

## **How to Remove Your Payment Card If You Bought Through Google Play**

If you purchased your Avast subscription through the Google Play Store, your payment card is stored with Google, not with Avast. (+1) 877 419 8702 To remove your card, you need to go into your Google Play account settings.

(+1) 877 419 8702 Open the Google Play Store app on your Android phone or tablet, tap your profile picture in the top right corner, then tap "Payments and subscriptions," then "Payment methods." (+1) 877 419 8702 You will see a list of your saved cards; tap the card you want to remove, then tap "Remove" or "Delete."

(+1) 877 419 8702 If you have an active Avast subscription through Google Play, Google may not let you remove your card until you cancel that subscription first.

(+1) 877 419 8702 To cancel the Avast subscription, go back to "Payments and subscriptions," tap "Subscriptions," find Avast, tap "Cancel subscription," and follow the prompts. (+1) 877 419 8702 After cancellation, return to Payment methods

and remove your card. (+1) 877 419 8702 You can also remove your card from your Google account on a computer by going to [myaccount.google.com](https://myaccount.google.com), clicking "Payment and subscriptions," then "Payment methods," and deleting the card from there. ## **How to Remove Your Payment Card Without Losing Access to Your Current Subscription**

Some people want to remove their card but still keep using Avast until their paid period ends. (+1) 877 419 8702 This is tricky because Avast usually requires a valid payment method on file for active subscriptions. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you remove your card while your subscription is still active, Avast may immediately ask you to add a new card, or they may cancel your subscription early. (+1) 877 419 8702 To avoid losing access, you should first turn off auto renewal (unsubscribe) so that your subscription will end on its expiration date. (+1) 877 419 8702 Then, after auto renewal is off, you can try to remove your card. (+1) 877 419 8702 If Avast still does not allow removal because the subscription is still active (even without auto renewal), you have two options: wait until your subscription expires, then remove the card, or call Avast support at (+1) 877 419 8702 and ask them to manually delete your card while keeping your service active until expiration. (+1) 877 419 8702 Some representatives may do this, but it is not guaranteed. (+1) 877 419 8702 The safest method is to let your subscription run out, then remove the card immediately after expiration. (+1) 877 419 8702

## **What to Do If You Cannot Find the Option to Remove Your Card**

Sometimes the "Remove" button is grayed out, missing, or hidden. (+1) 877 419 8702 This usually happens because you have an active subscription that requires a payment method. (+1) 877 419 8702 First, go to your Subscriptions page in your Avast account and check if auto renewal is turned

on. (+1) 877 419 8702 If auto renewal is on, turn it off first.  
(+1) 877 419 8702 After turning off auto renewal, wait a few minutes and refresh the Payment Methods page; the remove option may appear.  
(+1) 877 419 8702 If it still does not appear, try using a different web browser or clearing your browser cache and cookies. (+1) 877 419 8702 Sometimes the Avast website has temporary glitches. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you still cannot find the option, call Avast customer support at (+1) 877 419 8702 and ask them to delete your payment card from their system. (+1) 877 419 8702 Be prepared to verify your identity by providing your account email and the last four digits of the card you want to remove. (+1) 877 419 8702 Support can remove the card from their backend even if the option is not visible to you. (+1) 877 419 8702 If Avast refuses to remove your card, you have the right to contact your credit card company and ask them to block future charges from Avast, but that is a separate process.

## **How to Verify That Your Payment Card Has Been Successfully Removed**

After you remove your payment card, you should receive a confirmation email from Avast within a few minutes. (+1) 877 419 8702 Save this email as proof that you removed the card. (+1) 877 419 8702 You can also sign back into your Avast account at [account.avast.com](https://account.avast.com), go to Payment Methods, and check that no card is listed or that the card you removed is gone. (+1) 877 419 8702 If the page says "No payment method on file" or shows an empty list, you have successfully removed your card. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you removed your card through Apple or Google, log into your Apple ID or Google account and verify that the card is no longer listed under payment methods. (+1) 877 419 8702 Also, check your email for confirmation from Apple or Google. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you are still unsure, wait until your next billing date and check your credit card statement; if no charge appears, the removal worked. (+1) 877 419 8702 If a charge does appear despite removing your card, call Avast immediately at (+1) 877 419 8702 and dispute the charge with your credit card company. (+1) 877 419 8702

## **Frequently Asked Questions About Removing a Payment Card from Avast**

Can I remove my credit card from Avast without canceling my subscription? Usually not, because Avast requires a valid payment method for active subscriptions; you need to turn off auto renewal first, or wait until the subscription expires.

Will Avast still charge me after I remove my card? No, if the card is removed, Avast cannot charge that card, but if you have an active subscription, they may try to charge you and then suspend your account when the payment fails; always cancel the subscription first. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702

How do I remove my PayPal account from Avast? The process is similar to removing a credit card: go to Payment Methods in your Avast account, find PayPal, and click "Remove." If you cannot see it, call Avast at (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 for help.

What if I lost access to my Avast account email? You need to call Avast customer support at (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 and provide identifying information such as your full name, billing address, or last four digits of the card to verify your identity, and then they can remove the card for you. Can I add a different card before removing the old one? Yes, you can add a new card first, then remove the old one; this is useful if you need to keep your subscription active but want to change cards. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702

Does removing my card delete my Avast account? No, removing your payment card only deletes the card information; your Avast account and any remaining subscription time stay intact. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702

How do I remove a virtual card or one-time payment method? Virtual cards or one-time payment methods are usually not stored for future use, so you may not need to remove them; but if they appear in your account, follow the same removal steps or call (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702

What if Avast keeps charging me after I removed my card? If Avast charges a card you removed, it means the card was still stored elsewhere (like Apple or Google) or Avast had a backup method; call Avast at (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 and also contact your bank to dispute the charge.
