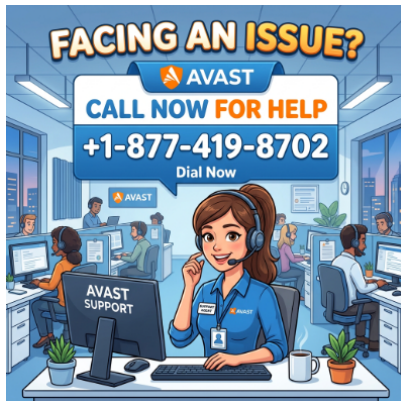


✧ How to Cancel Avast Subscription? – 2026 Fast & Easy Guide ✧



You want to cancel your Avast subscription and stop future charges, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ so follow this simple step-by-step guide below, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ because turning off auto-renewal is the only way to prevent recurring payments, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ and uninstalling the software does nothing to stop the billing agreement.

🖥️ Method 1 – Cancel Online Through Your Avast Account



Open your browser and go to the official Avast account portal at my.avast.com, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ then enter your email address and password to sign in, and if you forgot your password, click “Forgot Password” to reset it, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ then check your email for a reset link.

Once logged in, click on “Subscriptions” or “My Subscriptions” from the dashboard, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ then find the active Avast

product you want to cancel, and look for a link or button that says “Cancel Subscription” or “Turn Off Auto-Renewal”, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 and click it.

Confirm the cancellation when prompted by the system, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 and Avast will send a confirmation email to your registered address, so save that email as your permanent proof of cancellation, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 because you may need it if any billing dispute arises later.

If you do not see a cancellation option in your account, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 or if the button is grayed out, you may need to contact Avast support directly, because some subscriptions require manual cancellation by an agent, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 so call the number below for immediate help.

Method 2 – Cancel by Phone (Fastest & Most Reliable)

Dial the official Avast customer support line at (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 and when the agent answers, say clearly: “I want to cancel my entire Avast subscription and turn off auto-renewal permanently”, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 and they will ask for your email address or the last four digits of your credit card, so have that information ready before you call.

Once they verify your identity, they disable auto-renewal instantly, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 and give you a confirmation number before you hang up, so write that number down and keep it in a safe place, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 because this is your proof that the subscription is canceled.

Phone cancellation takes only 3-5 minutes of talk time, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 and hold times are shortest on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, while Monday mornings and Fridays are the busiest, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 so plan your call accordingly to avoid long waits.

For extra safety, you can call again the next day and ask a different agent to verify, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 📞 that your auto-renewal still shows “OFF” in their system, because having a second confirmation gives you total peace of mind.

Method 3 – If You Bought Through Apple, Google, or Amazon

If you purchased Avast from the Apple App Store on your iPhone or iPad, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ you cannot cancel on the Avast website at all, so go to Settings > your name > Subscriptions > select Avast, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ then tap “Cancel Subscription” to stop future renewals directly through Apple, and your billing will stop immediately.

For Google Play purchases on an Android device, open the Play Store app, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ tap your profile icon, select “Payments & Subscriptions”, then “Subscriptions”, find Avast, and tap “Cancel”, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ and your subscription will end at the next billing cycle, with no further charges.

For Amazon purchases, log into your Amazon account on a browser, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ go to “Account & Lists” > “Memberships & Subscriptions”, find Avast, click “Cancel”, and confirm, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ and your subscription will not renew after the current term ends, so you are done.

If you are unsure where you bought your Avast subscription, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ call the official support line and the agent can look up your purchase source using your email address or credit card, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ and then guide you to the correct cancellation method.

Bonus – How to Get a Refund If You Were Already Charged

If Avast already charged you for a renewal after you canceled, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ you may have up to 30 days from the charge date to request a refund, depending on your subscription type and region, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ so call the billing department and say: “My Avast subscription auto-renewed without my permission – please refund me.”

The agent will verify your account, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ then process the refund if you are within the refund window, giving you a confirmation number for the refund as well, (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ so save that number too.

? Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: How do I cancel my Avast subscription without logging in?

Call the official Avast support line at (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ and the agent will verify your identity using your name or credit card, then cancel auto-renewal over the phone, without needing any password.

Q2: Will uninstalling Avast stop future billing charges?

No, uninstalling the software only removes the program from your computer, the billing agreement stays active, so you must cancel auto-renewal separately to stop future charges.

Q3: Can I cancel my Avast subscription at any time?

Yes, you can cancel at any time without penalty, and your protection will continue until your current paid term ends, so you do not lose coverage immediately.

Q4: How long does it take to cancel Avast over the phone?

The conversation with the agent takes 3-5 minutes, plus any hold time which is shortest on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, so you can be done in under 10 minutes.

Q5: What is the direct number to cancel Avast right now?

Call the official Avast billing support line at (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ – this is the number for cancellations, and a live agent will disable auto-renewal for you instantly.

Q6: Does canceling my subscription automatically give me a refund?

No, canceling only stops future bills from happening, you will not get a refund for the current term unless you request it separately within the 30-day refund window.

Q7: How do I cancel Avast if I bought it through the Apple App Store?

Go to Settings > your name > Subscriptions > select Avast, then tap “Cancel Subscription” – this stops future billing immediately, and Avast cannot help you with Apple purchases.

Q8: Can Avast still charge me after I cancel?

No, once auto-renewal is turned off, Avast will not generate any future bills, but if you cancel close to your renewal date, a pending charge may still go through, so request a refund if that happens.

Q9: How do I remove my credit card from Avast after canceling?

After canceling auto-renewal, log into my.avast.com, go to Billing Information, and

click "Remove" next to your card, or call the support line to have an agent delete it for you.

Q10: What happens if I ignore Avast's renewal notice emails?

If you ignore them, Avast will automatically charge your card on the renewal date, so you must actively cancel auto-renewal to stop future billing charges, do not rely on ignoring emails.

🏁 Final Action Plan – Cancel Your Avast Subscription Today



Step one: decide whether to cancel online or by phone – online takes 5-10 minutes, but phone is faster if you want to avoid menus and ensure verification, so calling (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ is the most reliable method.

Step two: if you choose phone, dial (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 ☎ on a Tuesday or Wednesday morning, and have your email or credit card ready before you call, then tell the agent you want to cancel auto-renewal permanently.

Step three: after canceling, save the confirmation number the agent gives you, then remove your credit card from the billing information section, and if you were charged recently, ask for a refund in the same call, so you are fully protected.
