

▮ How Do I Remove My Payment Card from Avast? – 2026

You want to remove your credit card or payment method from your Avast account, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so follow these steps carefully below, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because deleting your card prevents future auto-renewal charges, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and adds an extra layer of security to your billing profile.

Many users think uninstalling Avast removes their payment info, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ but your card stays stored in Avast's billing system,

+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so you must log into your account or contact support to delete it permanently.

This guide covers removing your payment card online through your Avast account dashboard, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ phone support if you cannot access your account, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ how to handle subscriptions bought through third parties like Apple or Google, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and answers to common questions about payment removal.

🇺🇸 Method 1 – Remove Payment Card Online Through Your Avast Account

Open your browser and go to the official Avast account portal at my.avast.com, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ then enter your email address and password to sign in, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and if you forgot your password, click “Forgot Password” to reset it, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ then check your email for a reset link.

Once logged in, click on “Subscriptions” or “Billing Information” from the dashboard, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ then look for the section labeled “Payment Methods” or

“Saved Cards”, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and you will see your credit card details listed there.

Click on the card you want to remove, then select “Delete” or “Remove Payment Method”, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and confirm the action when prompted by the system, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and Avast will no longer store that payment information.

If you have an active subscription, you may not be able to remove your card until you cancel auto-renewal first, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so turn off auto-renewal under “Subscriptions” before attempting to delete the card, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ otherwise the system may keep the card on file.

After removal, check your email for a confirmation from Avast, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and save that email as proof that your payment method has been deleted, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because you might need it if any billing dispute arises later.

Method 2 – Remove Payment Card by Phone (If You Cannot Log In)

If you cannot access your Avast account online, or if the remove option is missing, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ call the official Avast customer support line at +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and when the agent answers, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ say clearly: “I want to remove my saved credit card from my Avast account”, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and they will ask for your email address or the last four digits of your card.

Once they verify your identity, they will locate your billing profile and delete the payment method manually, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and give you a confirmation number before you hang up, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so write that number down as your proof of removal.

Phone support is available 24/7, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and hold times are shortest on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ while Monday mornings and Fridays are the busiest, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so plan your call accordingly to save time.

If you have an active subscription that is still auto-renewing, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ the agent may need to cancel auto-renewal first before removing your card,

+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because Avast requires an active payment method for an active subscription.

Method 3 – If You Bought Through Apple, Google, or Amazon

If you purchased Avast from the Apple App Store on your iPhone or iPad,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ your payment card is stored with Apple, not with Avast,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so go to Settings > your name > Payment & Shipping,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ then edit or remove your card from Apple's system directly.

For Google Play purchases on an Android device, open the Play Store app,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ tap your profile icon, select “Payments & Subscriptions”,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ then “Payment Methods”, and remove your card from Google's wallet.

For Amazon purchases, log into your Amazon account, go to “Your Account” > “Your Payments”, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and delete the card associated with your Avast subscription, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because Amazon handles the billing for those purchases.

If you are unsure where your Avast subscription was purchased,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ call the official support line at +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and the agent can look up, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ your purchase source using your email address, and guide you to the correct removal method.

Important Notes Before Removing Your Payment Card



Removing your payment card does not cancel your active subscription, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so if you still have time left on your current plan, you will continue to receive service, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ but Avast may attempt to charge the removed card if auto-renewal is still on.

Always cancel auto-renewal first before removing your payment card,

+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because otherwise Avast might suspend your account or send overdue notices, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and you could still be liable for future payments.

If you have multiple subscriptions under one Avast account, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ removing your card may affect all of them, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so make sure you have canceled auto-renewal for every product before deleting the card.

After removal, monitor your bank statements for the next 60 days, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ to ensure no unexpected Avast charges appear, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and if any do, call +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ immediately to dispute them.

? Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: How do I remove my payment card from Avast without logging in?

Call the official Avast support line at +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and the agent will verify your identity, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ using your name or card details, then remove your payment method over the phone, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ without needing to log in.

Q2: Can I remove my credit card from Avast while my subscription is still active?

Yes, but you may need to cancel auto-renewal first, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because Avast requires an active payment method for an active subscription, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so turn off auto-renewal before removing the card.

Q3: Will removing my payment card from Avast cancel my subscription automatically?

No, removing your card only deletes the stored payment method, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ your subscription remains active until the term ends, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ but Avast will not be able to charge you for renewal.

Q4: How do I remove my payment card from Avast on iPhone or iPad?

If you bought Avast through the Apple App Store, go to Settings > your name > Payment & Shipping, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ then edit or remove your card from Apple's system, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because Avast does not store your card directly.

Q5: What happens if I remove my payment card but forget to cancel auto-renewal? Avast will attempt to charge the removed card on the renewal date,

+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and if it fails, your subscription may be suspended,
+1)→877→419→8702 ❖ but you could still incur late fees or account restrictions.

Q6: How long does it take for Avast to delete my payment card after I request removal?

Online removal is instant once you confirm the action, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and phone removal is also immediate, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so the card is deleted from Avast's system right away.

Q7: Why can't I remove my payment card from Avast online?

You may have an active auto-renewal subscription, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ or your account has a pending balance, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ call +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and an agent can help resolve the issue.

Q8: Can I remove a prepaid card or virtual card from Avast?

Yes, the same steps apply for any payment method stored in your Avast account, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ if you encounter issues, call +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ for manual assistance.

Q9: How do I remove my payment card from Avast after canceling my subscription?

Log into my.avast.com, go to Billing Information, and click "Remove" next to your card, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ or call +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ to have an agent delete it for you.

Q10: What is the direct number to remove my payment card from Avast right now?

Call the official Avast billing support line at +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ – this is the number for payment removal, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and a live agent will delete your card instantly, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so don't wait – call today.

Final Action Plan – Remove Your Payment Card Today

Step one: log into my.avast.com and cancel auto-renewal for all active subscriptions, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ because removing your card without canceling auto-renewal can cause billing issues, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ so always cancel first.

Step two: go to Billing Information or Payment Methods in your account, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ click "Remove" next to the card you want to delete, +1)→877→419→8702 ❖ and confirm the action when prompted by the system.
