

How to Cancel Avast Subscription and Stop Future Billing Charges– 2026 Permanent Fix

Introduction

You want to cancel your Avast subscription and stop all future billing charges. (+1) 877 419 8702 Maybe you are tired of seeing unexpected charges on your credit card every year. Important: Understand What Cancels Future Billing and What Does Not

Before you take any action, you must understand which actions stop future billing charges and which actions do nothing. (+1) 877 419 8702 Canceling your subscription means ending your paid plan so that Avast will not renew and you will never be billed again. (+1) 877 419 8702 Turning off auto renewal (also called unsubscribing) means you stop future payments but your current protection continues until your paid period ends, and after that no more charges. (+1) 877 419 8702 Both canceling and turning off auto renewal stop future billing charges. (+1) 877 419 8702 However, uninstalling the Avast software from your computer does NOT stop future billing charges because your subscription remains active in Avast's system. temporarily does NOT stop future billing charges because that only pauses protection for a few minutes or hours. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Deactivating Avast on one device does NOT stop future billing charges because your subscription is still active on your account. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Here is the most important thing to remember: if you want to stop future billing charges, you must either cancel your subscription or turn off auto renewal directly through your Avast account, Apple, or Google depending on where you bought it. Before You Cancel Your Avast Subscription

Before you cancel, there are a few things you should know to avoid surprises. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 When you cancel your Avast subscription, your antivirus protection will continue working until your current paid period ends. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 For example, if you paid for a full year and you cancel after six months, you will still have protection for the remaining six months, but you will not be charged again. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 If you want a refund for the unused portion, you need to request a refund separately within the refund window (typically thirty to sixty days from purchase). (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Also, canceling leaves your computer unprotected after your current period ends, so make sure you have another antivirus solution ready such as Microsoft Defender which is free on Windows. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 If you only want to remove Avast from one device but keep paying for others, you should deactivate that device instead of canceling the whole subscription. How to Cancel Avast Subscription and Stop Future Billing on the Avast Website

The most reliable way to cancel your Avast subscription and stop future billing charges is through your Avast account on the official website. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 First, open your web browser and go to account.avast.com. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Sign in with your email address and password; if you forgot your password, click the "Forgot password" link to reset it. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Once you are signed in, look

for "Subscriptions" or "My Subscriptions" and click on it. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 You will see a list of every Avast product and subscription linked to your account. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Look for a button or link that says "Cancel Subscription," "Turn Off Auto Renewal," or "Manage Renewal." How to Cancel and Stop Future Billing If You Bought Avast Through Apple (App Store)

If you purchased your Avast subscription through the Apple App Store on your iPhone, iPad, or Mac, you cannot cancel through Avast and you cannot stop future billing charges through Avast. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 You must cancel through Apple because Apple handles all billing for App Store purchases. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 On an iPhone or iPad, open the Settings app, tap your name at the top, then tap "Subscriptions." (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 You will see a list of all active and expired subscriptions linked to your Apple ID. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Find Avast in the list and tap on it. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Tap "Cancel Subscription" or "Cancel Free Trial" depending on your status. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Confirm your choice, and Apple will turn off auto renewal so that future billing charges stop. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 On a Mac, open the App Store, click your name in the bottom left corner, then click "View Information." (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Scroll down to Subscriptions, click "Manage," find Avast, and click "Cancel." (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 After you cancel through Apple, you will receive a confirmation email from Apple, and you should save that email. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 Your Avast protection will continue until the end of your current billing cycle, but no future charges will occur. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 If you want a refund for the current period, you need to request that separately through Apple's refund system at reportaproblem.apple.com. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702

How to Cancel and Stop Future Billing If You Bought Avast Through Google Play

If you purchased your Avast subscription through the Google Play Store on your Android phone, you must cancel through Google to stop future billing charges.

(+1) 877 419 8702 Avast cannot cancel subscriptions bought through Google because Google processes all payments for Play Store purchases.

(+1) 877 419 8702 Open the Google Play Store app on your Android device.

(+1) 877 419 8702 Tap your profile picture in the top right corner, then tap "Payments and subscriptions." (+1) 877 419 8702 Tap "Subscriptions," and you will see a list of all your active subscriptions. (+1) 877 419 8702 Find Avast in the list and tap on it. (+1) 877 419 8702 Tap "Cancel subscription" and follow the on-screen prompts to confirm. (+1) 877 419 8702 Google will ask you to select a reason for canceling, and you can choose any option that applies.

(+1) 877 419 8702 After you confirm, Google will turn off automatic renewal, and future billing charges will stop immediately. (+1) 877 419 8702 You will receive a confirmation email from Google, and you should save that email as proof.

(+1) 877 419 8702 Your Avast protection will continue until your current paid period ends, but you will never be charged again after that. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you want a refund for the current period, you can request it through Google Play within forty-eight hours for automatic approval, or up to fourteen days if you contact support. How to Stop Future Billing Charges Without Losing Your Remaining Time (Turn Off Auto Renewal Only)

If you want to stop future billing charges but you do not want a refund and you want to keep using Avast until your current paid period ends, you should turn off auto renewal instead of canceling immediately. (+1) 877 419 8702 Some people confuse canceling with turning off auto renewal, but there is a difference.

(+1) 877 419 8702 When you cancel your subscription on Avast's website, sometimes your access ends immediately depending on the plan.

(+1) 877 419 8702 When you simply turn off auto renewal, your access continues until your expiration date, and then the subscription expires naturally with no future charges. (+1) 877 419 8702 To turn off auto renewal, sign in to

account.avast.com, go to Subscriptions, find your Avast product, and click "Manage Renewal" or "Billing Settings." (+1) 877 419 8702 Look for a toggle or checkbox that says "Auto Renewal" or "Automatic Renewal" and set it to "Off" or "Do Not Renew." (+1) 877 419 8702 Avast will ask you to confirm, and you may be offered a discount to keep auto renewal on; decline if you want to stop future billing charges. (+1) 877 419 8702 After you turn off auto renewal, you will see a message that your subscription will expire on a specific date and will not renew. (+1) 877 419 8702 You will also receive a confirmation email. (+1) 877 419 8702 This method is perfect if you want to stop future billing charges but you do not want to lose the protection you already paid for. (+1) 877 419 8702

What If You Cannot Find the Cancel or Auto Renewal Button?

Sometimes users have trouble finding the cancellation or auto renewal settings on the Avast website. (+1) 877 419 8702 Avast does not hide these options, but the wording can change over time. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you cannot find a button that says "Cancel Subscription," look for "Manage Renewal," "Billing Settings," or "Subscription Settings." (+1) 877 419 8702 Click on those, and the cancellation option is usually inside. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you are still unable to find it, try logging out of your account and logging back in, or clear your browser cache and cookies. How to Verify That Future Billing Charges Have Been Stopped

After you cancel or turn off auto renewal, you should take a few steps to verify that future billing charges will not happen. (+1) 877 419 8702 First, check your email inbox for a confirmation message from Avast, Apple, or Google depending on where you canceled. (+1) 877 419 8702 This email is your proof, so save it in a folder or

take a screenshot. (+1) 877 419 8702 Second, sign back into your Avast account at account.avast.com and go to Subscriptions. (+1) 877 419 8702 Your subscription status should show "Expires on [date]" with no mention of automatic renewal or next billing date. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you turned off auto renewal, you should see a message that auto renewal is disabled. (+1) 877 419 8702 Third, check the payment method you used (credit card, PayPal, etc.) and look for any pending authorizations from Avast. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you see one, contact Avast support at (+1) 877 419 8702 to have it removed. (+1) 877 419 8702 Fourth, mark your next renewal date on a calendar and check your bank or credit card statement a few days after that date. (+1) 877 419 8702 If no charge appears, you have successfully stopped future billing charges. (+1) 877 419 8702 If a charge does appear, call Avast immediately at (+1) 877 419 8702 and dispute the charge with your credit card company. (+1) 877 419 8702

What to Do If Avast Keeps Charging You After You Cancel

If you canceled your subscription but Avast still charged you on your next renewal date, do not panic because this happens to many people. (+1) 877 419 8702 First, check your cancellation confirmation email to find the exact date and time you canceled. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you canceled after the renewal processed, the charge may be legitimate for the next period, but you can still request a refund. (+1) 877 419 8702 Second, call Avast customer support at (+1) 877 419 8702 and explain that you canceled before the renewal date but were charged anyway. (+1) 877 419 8702 Provide your account email and the date of the charge, and ask for a full refund. (+1) 877 419 8702 Most of the time, Avast will refund you if you are within the refund window. (+1) 877 419 8702 Third, if Avast refuses to refund you, contact your credit card company or bank and dispute the charge as an unauthorized transaction. (+1) 877 419 8702 Tell them that you canceled the subscription before the renewal date and that Avast charged you anyway. (+1) 877 419 8702 Most credit card companies will reverse the charge and issue a chargeback. (+1) 877 419 8702 Fourth, after getting your refund, double-check that auto renewal is completely turned off by signing into your Avast account again. (+1) 877 419 8702 If you cannot sign in, ask support to confirm that your account is marked as canceled. (+1) 877 419 8702 To prevent this from happening again, consider removing your credit card information from your Avast account or using a virtual credit card for future subscriptions. Frequently Asked Questions About Stopping Future Billing Charges

How do I cancel my Avast subscription and stop future billing charges? Sign in to account.avast.com, go to Subscriptions, find your product, and click "Cancel Subscription" or "Turn Off Auto Renewal." (+1) 877 419 8702 If you bought through Apple or Google, cancel through their stores instead. (+1) 877 419 8702

Does uninstalling Avast stop future billing charges? No, uninstalling only removes the software and does nothing to stop your subscription payments. (+1) 877 419 8702

If I cancel, will I lose my remaining protection time? Usually not if you turn off auto renewal, but some cancellation methods may end access immediately; always choose "Turn Off Auto Renewal" to keep protection until your expiration date. (+1) 877 419 8702

How can I stop Avast from automatically renewing without canceling my current plan? Turn off auto renewal in your Avast account settings under Subscriptions. (+1) 877 419 8702

What if I lost access to my Avast account email? Call Avast support at (+1) 877 419 8702 and provide your full name, billing address, and last four digits of your credit card to verify your identity, then ask them to cancel for you. (+1) 877 419 8702

Can Avast charge me after I cancel? If you successfully cancel or turn off auto renewal, Avast should not charge you again, but mistakes happen; always verify and keep your confirmation email. (+1) 877 419 8702

How soon after canceling will I see that future billing charges have stopped? Immediately in your Avast account status, but you will only know for sure on your next renewal date when no charge appears. (+1) 877 419 8702

What if I have multiple Avast subscriptions under one account? You need to cancel each subscription individually because turning off auto renewal for one product does not affect others. (+1) 877 419 8702

Can I stop future billing charges if I paid with PayPal? Yes, you can cancel through your Avast account, and you can also log into PayPal, go to Settings, then Payments, then Automatic Payments, and remove Avast's permission to bill you. (+1) 877 419 8702

What happens if I cancel but then change my mind later? You can reactivate your subscription anytime before your expiration date by signing into your Avast account and turning auto renewal back on. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702

Quick Reference: How to Stop Future Billing Charges Based on Your Purchase Method

If you bought Avast directly from the Avast website, you stop future billing charges by signing into account.avast.com and canceling or turning off auto renewal.

(+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 If you bought Avast through the Apple App Store, you stop future billing charges by going to Settings on your iPhone or iPad, tapping your name, then Subscriptions, and canceling Avast. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 If you bought Avast through the Google Play Store, you stop future billing charges by opening the Google Play Store app, tapping your profile picture, then Payments and subscriptions, then Subscriptions, and canceling Avast. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 If you bought Avast through a third party like Amazon or Best Buy, you must cancel future billing charges through that retailer because Avast does not manage your payment.

(+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702 No matter which method you used, the most important step is to take action before your next renewal date, because waiting until after the charge appears makes it harder to get your money back. (+1) > 877 > 419 > 8702
